Introducing The Deep Dive, the second intercollegiate learning program in Unify America's Civic Gym series. Thanks to requests from educators and participants in the Unify Challenge College Bowl, students now have a chance to "go deep" into a **single topic** to practice critical civic skills in a one-on-one setting.

A deep dive into critical thinking and constructive dialogue

Whether assigned as a standalone experience or as a follow-up to the College Bowl, The Deep Dive enables students to connect across institutions, engage in meaningful, solutions-based dialogue about pressing national issues, and develop essential skills, including:



Active Listening and Perspective Sharing: Students have the chance to hear and summarize each other's personal experiences and points of view.

- **Critical Thinking and Analysis:** The pairs review, evaluate, and discuss researched facts on the issue.

Self Evaluation: Students closely examine their own perspectives in light of new information and their partner's follow-up questions.



Collaborative Problem Solving: Students work together to brainstorm solutions to pressing problems in America.

Discussion Question: How do your personal

experiences shape your opinions on the issue of

gun ownership?



Connecting intercollegiate peers

Here's how it works. Students complete a brief sign-up form and choose a timeslot. On the night of the event, they join a virtual session and meet their partner — another student from across the nation with a different perspective.
