Campuses whose President, Provost, or Chancellor signed ALL IN's Presidents' Commitment to Full Voter Participation had an average 2020 voter turnout rate **5.7 percentage points higher** than other campuses.

STANDOUT PRESIDENT AWARD

Recognition is a key component of <u>ALL IN's theory of change</u>. The ALL IN Campus Democracy Challenge hosts a biennial Awards Ceremony in odd-numbered years to recognize campuses, campus voting coalitions, and individuals working to increase nonpartisan college student democratic engagement.
